



#### QUESTION 11

Plymouth Environmental Co., Inc. performed an asbestos abatement project at a school building in the State of Delaware during the summer of 1995. During an investigation by the Department of Administrative Services it was determined that Plymouth Environmental Co., Inc. was in violation for poor performance for failure to supply critical seals and failure to adequately wet asbestos containing material. As a result, Plymouth Environmental Co., Inc. license to perform asbestos abatement was suspended for a period of ninety days. This was a result of one foreman who maliciously and willfully violated Delaware's asbestos control regulations. This foreman was discharged from the company.

Since that time, Plymouth Environmental Co., Inc. has performed hundreds of projects in the State of Delaware. All of these projects have been completed without incident.
